

POSITION: BILINGUAL LEAD TEACHER

Tampa Bay International School seeks a bilingual (Spanish/English) Lead Teacher to join our faculty for the 2021-2022 school year, when our school expands to serve an anticipated 25-30 students.

The desired applicant should:

- be an energetic, empathetic, and creative educator who loves working with children
- collaborate well with others
- fully support multilingualism and multilingual education
- have experience working with children in an elementary school setting
- possess a degree in education or a related field
- embrace the school's belief in actively promoting the Jewish tenets of *tikkun olam* and *tzedakah* (social justice); *shmirat ha adamah* (caring for the Earth) and *shalom* (peace)
- possess a love of the arts and a desire to allow children to express themselves artistically
- embrace a global perspective that recognizes and appreciates a diversity of cultures
- be able to teach academic content in both Spanish and English
- have experience teaching math to students in upper elementary years (3rd grade and up)
- fully support the mission of Tampa Bay International School: to foster multilingualism, embrace diversity, and inspire children to work for a just and sustainable planet through a program rich in the arts.

Work Hours: Monday-Friday, 8:00 AM - 4:30 PM with additional hours as needed to plan instruction

Salary: \$40,000 - \$42,000 annually; additional compensation may be available through employment in afterschool program, winter and summer camp.

Duties:

- Teach children in grades K-6 in all subjects, including reading, writing, math, science and social studies
- Perform academic assessments of students
- Supervise children during lunch, recess, and before the school day
- Communicate with parents regarding children's academic performance and social-emotional well-being
- Prepare student progress reports
- Work outdoors; position requires ability to move freely about campus and occasionally carry and move furniture and equipment which may weigh 10-20 pounds
